Bullies AAA Frequently Ask Questions?

Why play for the Bullies?

This is the perfect time for players to get to know our Bullies Staff. Our coaching staff is made up of College, Prep, Junior, Professional and Amateur area scouts. In the off months this is not a big commitment and gives our staff the time to meet future Junior, Prep and Public school players and their families. This program offers top players from different teams to compete together and enjoy playing hockey. It also gives our select players an opportunity to see our coaching styles and method.

What We Expect From Our Players.

We expect each player to do the best they can to make each game and practice. We expect each player to act responsibly on and off the ice. We expect each player to show the willingness to learn and be a part of the team. We expect each player to respect the coaching staff, players and each opponent. We expect each player to enjoy themselves and take something out of playing for the Bullies.

What is the Goal of the Bullies teams?

The Beantown Bullies have so many goals we want to accomplish. One, and the most important is for each of our players to learn something new, accomplish something new, take on a new role where their game is lacking, better their game in an area they want to improve. Another goal is to be competitive and compete in each tournament we play in. We put together the most competitive teams as possible and teach our players how to "Play the Game" of hockey by playing with other top players and top coaching.

How many players do you bring to each tournament?

This varies on the age and period length of games at that tournament. At the younger ages (13 and Under) we will normally carry 10 forwards, 6 defensemen and 2 goalies. At the oldest age levels (14-20 year olds) we may carry 4 lines depending on the tournament.

Do all players get equal playing time?

Every player we select is a top player and therefore we try to give each player an equal amount of ice time. In the last seven - five minutes of a game the coach may shorten the bench to give the team the best opportunity to win the game. This also happens in the playoff rounds.

Who selects the teams?

Each team will be selected by Bullies scouts and coaches. We have a wide variety of contacts in the hockey community.

Will my son miss any school time?

Ultimately in the end we have no control of the tournament schedule but we do ask the tournament coordinators to schedule our teams after school hours if possible.....sometimes they do, sometimes they don't. You may have to miss the occasional Friday.

Are the players required to make all the practices?

No it is not mandatory but it is *strongly* recommended. The Bullies players will be top players from different teams. They will need to get to know each other on the ice to be successful. The coach will also need time to implement their "system" in place. Please do the best you can to make all practices.
